Attend to your heart,

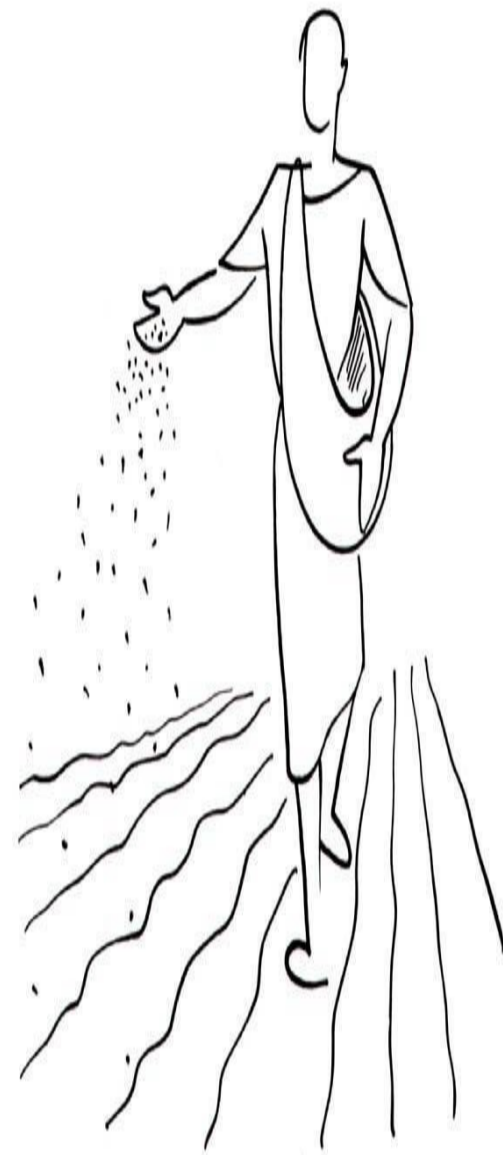
your hardness, your shallowness, your thorns.
