Philippians 4:4

Rejoice!

Today, the Third Sunday of Advent, is a special Sunday in our season of waiting for the coming of Jesus. Traditionally, this Sunday is called the Sunday of Joy, from the Latin name Gaudete, which means justly - rejoice. So today we are called in a special way to rejoice. But do we have any reason to rejoice? Some would simply say that we do not. After all, there is so much violence, so much suffering in the world today. So many people are homeless, orphans ... and on and on. This is true, and each of us is well

aware of it, but still we are called to rejoice. Not because there is no evil or suffering, but because someone is coming to clean up this whole - let us call it - "mess". Is that not a reason to rejoice? Thanks to the first coming of Jesus, which we will remember again in a week's time, and all that He did for us by living among us and dying for us, we have been given the chance to come closer to the God we can call Father. It is a cause for boundless joy and pride that we little ones have been called children of the Almighty Himself! The Second Coming of the Lord will in the end consolidate His reign and transform everything according to His plan. All those who belong to Him will experience unspeakable happiness that will last forever! The Lord has promised this and will certainly fulfil it. But will we be among the elect? If we do not feel worthy now, or if we have doubts, we still have time to change. Jesus always gives us a new chance in the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation. We can come to Him at any time and start again. We can also, if we wish, feed on the Saviour's body every day and receive the supernatural strength that enables us to transform our lives. All these gifts, and there are many more, are they not cause for rejoicing? So dear ones, let us rejoice!
