Harmony of Hearts

Harmony of Hearts is our theme in the Parish this Advent.
God is love. God's heart knows no boundaries.
God loves! God yearns for our love!

Through the Prophet Isaiah God calls to each of us, "Come back to me with all your hearts". Through John the Baptist God calls on us, "prepare the way of the Lord". Through the Angel Gabriel God spoke to the virgin of Nazareth, calling her by name, "Mary do not be

afraid". God calls each of us by name. Calls us not to be afraid! Calls us to respond! Like Joseph we are called to faith and called to action.

Our theme, *Harmony of Hearts*, invites us to allow our hearts to pulsate with the hearts of the people we are going to meet in the scriptures as we travel through the Advent season. We are invited to have "heart to heart", with Isaiah, with John the Baptist, with Mary, with Joseph and with many others. With them we are invited to have a "heart to heart" with God. "Listen, if today you

2024 Pioneer Calendar


