**Happy Time?** 



Although Lent doesn't necessarily seem like a 'happy' time, we can assume that God sees it as such.

He looks forward to it!

For Him, Lent is a fascinating and hopeful time when we, His children return to Him. God the Father wants each one of us to draw closer to Him and to experience His love. That is why he calls us to "turn to me with all your heart". This is the meaning of all our Lenten practices;

penance, fasting, almsgiving and finding extra time for prayer. Let us make these efforts not only out of obligation or in an attempt to separate ourselves from the world, but also in response to the call of a loving God. These practices will help us return to Him and reunite us with the One who loved us from the beginning. Every prayer, every sacrifice, every act of charity, is another step that brings us closer to the Father. The good news is that God has already come to meet us. He came close to us when He sent His Son, who came into the world as a man, and when He gave us the Holy Spirit. Our Heavenly Father is always there for us, but because of weakness and sin, we sometimes lose sight of His love and walk away. We need repentance to come back to Him, and there is no better opportunity to do this than Lent! Each of us has a choice. We can seize the opportunity of Lent and draw closer to our Lord, or we can withdraw and ignore God's generous invitation. Let us not lose what a loving God wants to give us.
