

### **Trinity Sunday: Our Call to Discipleship**

This Sunday, we encounter the risen Christ giving His final instructions to His disciples. Despite their initial doubt, Jesus reassures them with the profound declaration, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me." This affirmation of His divine authority underpins the Great Commission that follows.

Jesus commands His disciples—and by extension, all of us, to "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations."
