On this last Sunday of June, for some the first Sunday of the summer holidays, Jesus stands before us as the one who can do everything. In the case of the woman with the hemorrhage, in the case of Jairus' dead daughter, and in other situations described in the pages of Scripture, Jesus does things that defy logic, miracles of healing of body and spirit.
