Just as the Apostles had to learn to rely upon the providence of God in all things, so God wants the same for you. He might not call you to go forth on a mission without any physical provisions like in today's Gospel, but He does want you to learn to trust Him always. If you find this fearful, that is a good interior discovery. It means that you have found the fear that is holding you back. Whatever that may be, step forward in faith and conquer that fear. God will provide for you, giving you what you need to wonderfully fulfil His divine mission in your life. You are a child of God and your asked to live a life that reflect that truth, to be a light in the world a sign of Hope for those without.


