

Bishop Denis writes, "I invite all parishes to ring church bells next Wednesday (June 4th) at 1.05pm on UN Day of Innocent Children Victims of Aggression, in response to a peace initiative of the Fórsa Trade Union inviting workers to take a moment at lunchtime, and to observe Friday (June 6th) as a day of prayer and fasting in solidarity with all suffering in the Holy Land at this time."

The statement of the Bishop's Conference follows:

"It appears that humanity has lost its heart"

"We in Ireland must pray for a change of heart. Throughout the month of June – the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus – we call on everyone to pray for an outpouring of the compassion of God on a heartless world.

We echo Pope Leo XIV's recent appeal to allow into Gaza 'the entry of dignified humanitarian aid and to put an end to the hostilities, whose heartbreaking price is paid by the children, elderly, and the sick."

Columban Day Celebrations

All paths lead to Carlow this July when the town hosts the XXVI Columbanus Day celebration from 11th July to 13th July 2025. This significant occasion honours St Columbanus, one of Ireland's most influential early missionaries. St Columbanus, patron saint of the Missionary Society of St Columban, was born in Myshall. The three-day event promises a rich blend of cultural, spiritual and communal experiences.

Highlights include the launch of the exhibition 'Ireland and the Birth of Europe', a symposium exploring the relationship between creation and spirituality given by Columban missionary Fr Sean McDonagh, and a walk along the picturesque Columban Way. Visitors can also look forward to engaging talks, such as 'Columbanus, the Man from Myshall', by former President Dr Mary McAleese, taking place in the Holy Cross Church in Myshall. There will be an evening of sacred music in the Cathedral of the Assumption at 8pm on Saturday 12th July, the featuring Cathedral Choir, the Carlow Choral Society, Schola Cathedralis and Soloist Eva Kavanagh.
