Sunday First Reading

Listen to this, you who trample on the needy and try to suppress the poor.

Today's scripture from Amos has three powerful nouns contained in it, Listen, Trample and Suppress. These are echoed in the words of Jesus during his ministry when he walked among us. Thus, as followers of Jesus Christ and as Church, we must also reflect on them and how they might affect our lives.

We are called to **listen** to the call to love one another. If we truly embrace this first commandment, our outlook on life will be changed. To embrace this Love would make it impossible for us to trample on or suppress the poor. Without the love of Jesus Christ, we are capable of any sort of wrongdoing.

Unfortunately, because of the intellect we have been gifted by God, we find a way to justify our actions. This justification can range from lack of understanding to not adhering to God's commandment. While at the same time turning a blind eye to the wish of Jesus," I want people to lift their hands up reverently in prayer, with no anger or argument."
