# A question that we can't avoid but must be answered.

What is our individual and Parish response to Pope Leo's recent document called "Dilexi Te" (I have loved you)?

In this document Pope Leo XIV reminds us of the value of every Individual and the gift each person brings. He also reminds us that

looking after the poor is not an option but a command from Jesus Christ. It is part of the mission of the Church, to serve the poor. You and I are members of that same Church, the question is what are we doing in response to this call to serve the poor? As with the rich young man who kept all the commands of God, Jesus demands more of his followers to go further and love more.

Love for the Lord, then, is one with love for the poor. The same Jesus who tells us,

"The poor you will always have with you" (*Mt* 26:11), also promises the disciples: "I am with you always" (*Mt* 28:20). We likewise think of his saying: "Just as you did it to one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did it to me" (*Mt* 25:40). This is not a matter of mere human kindness but a revelation: contact with those who are lowly and powerless is a fundamental way of encountering the Lord of history. In the poor, he continues to speak to us.

What is our response to the mission to the poor. What do I do in response to the call to serve the poor? What do we do as a Parish to respond to the poor, who are our gift of opportunity to serve. In the same way as we cannot point to other's misbehaviour and say, oh! look at them and judge and condemn their action, neither can we look at those in our community who are doing good works and claim the good works of individuals/Church as ours.

When we meet Christ, we will be asked individually by him, what did you do in service of the poor, did you love me? Excuses of arrogance, ignorance, bias and prejudice will not be acceptable.

His response will be, if you did it to one of these you did it to me. Now that we have time, we need to explore what we can do so out response to Christ's question will be look at my actions Dilexi Te.

(I have loved you)
